

REQUEST FOR BIDS

Nurse Station Remodel and Pyxis Installation Project

The San Bernardino Mountains Community Healthcare District (“SBMCHD”) is seeking qualified contractors to publically bid on the **Nurse Station Remodel and Pyxis Installation Project**.

All information requested by the Bid materials must be provided in the form requested and will form the basis of the SBMCHD evaluation. The SBMCHD reserves the right to independently confirm all information provided by a bidder.

Hard copies of the Bid documents are available at the Mountains Community Hospital reception desk located at 29101 Hospital Road, Lake Arrowhead, California 92352. Electronic copies of the Bid Documents will be available upon request.

Mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting and Walk-Thru will be held at 1:00 p.m. on Tuesday August 3, 2021 at the Mountains Community Hospital.

All prospective Bidders must attend this Mandatory Pre-Bid meeting and Walk-Thru to be qualified to bid.

Sealed Bids, including mandatory bid security, will be due to the Mountains Community Hospital reception desk no later than **2:00 p.m. on Tuesday August 17, 2021**, after which they will be read publically.

All information provided as part of the Bidders Qualifications will be kept confidential to the extent permitted by law. However, contents may be disclosed to third parties for purpose of verification, in the investigation of substantial allegations, or in any appeal hearing.

The SBMCHD reserves the right to waive minor irregularities of form in the information contained in the Bidders Qualification questionnaire and will make all final determinations. Bidders must have a Class B License.

All prospective bidders are advised of the following:

- A. No contractor or subcontractor may submit a bid or be listed on the bid proposal for a public works project unless the bidder is registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 172.5 [with limited exceptions from this requirement for bid purposes only under Labor Code section 1771.1(a)] and has been pre-qualified by the Law Library.
- B. No contractor or subcontractor may be awarded a contract for public work on a public works project unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5.

- C. This project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations.
