'Tis the season of gift giving!!

The gift shop is filled with fun nick knacks to deck the halls during this holiday season.

Beginning December 17th through the 23rd, we will need extra hands as purchases made to be given as gifts will be gift wrapped. A table is being set up just outside the shop in the Solarium where items can be taken to be bagged with ribbons and tags.

If you don't normally work in the shop but would like to help out with gift bags, please let Lydia know as we expect to be busy with last minute gift purchases!

We are continuing to sell See's candy. In fact, it sold so quickly Lydia and Toneya plan to restock the shelves with additional boxes.

And lastly, so many staff requested we carry hooded, zip up sweatshirts with the MCH logo, that we decided purchase some in black and dark heather. The cost is \$39.95. Hoping this will meet the employees expectations.

- 1. Influenza (flu vaccine)
 - · Yearly before flu season
- 2. COVID-19 (SARS-COV-2) Vaccination
 - For 65+, two step recommended (1st dose followed by 2nd at least 4-6 months later)
- 3. RSV (Respiratory Syncytial Virus)
 - One time for those 60+ (or 55 based on risk)
- 4. Shingrix (Shingles Vaccine)
 - 2 doses, 2-6 months apart (protects against shingles and postherpetic neuralgia)
- 5. Pneumococcal Vaccine
 - Usually just one time (protects against pneumonia, bloodstream infections and meningitis
- 6. Tdap/Td Booster (Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis)
 - Every 10 years

These are the suggested 2025/2026 Recommendations for those 55+
